TECHNOLOGY: Life After Tech

For displaced workers, these 5 career paths are on the rise...

Thousands of tech jobs have vanished in the past year leaving tech workers displaced and searching for work. What lies ahead for these individuals?

According to LinkedIn News, 37.3% of displaced tech workers are staying in the technology, information, and media fields. Others are venturing into different or new industries. The most common career switch workers are making involves the professional services sector, which is dominated by consulting and accounting firms. That's where 19.6% of former tech workers find their next career chapter.

The other fields tech workers are transitioning into are financial services (8.3%), manufacturing (8.0%) and hospitals and healthcare (3.7%).

The fastest growing metros hiring displaced tech workers include Washington D.C.-Baltimore, Chicago, Austin, Salt Lake City, Miami-Fort Lauderdale and Phoenix.

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May Each of Us an Expert Overview

Emily Rothberg's Each of Us an Expert session in May, Retirement is a Process, focused on the important developmental task of planning for retirement.

The session was popular, with 24 participants and requests for the session to be recorded (which is available to MACCA members on the website).

Emily observed that retirement evokes a range of emotions, from a sense of freedom or relief, to fear and anxiety, and our task as counselors and coaches is to help clients make space for and then make sense of these emotions.

Concerns about retiring can be grouped into three categories: Identity, Community, and Structure.

People approaching retirement wonder who they will be when they no longer have a job. They worry about the loss of community and relationships. And many struggle with vast unscheduled blocks of time, after years of having the job provide structure to their lives. Emily cited a fascinating piece of research that identified the optimum amount of leisure time as 2–5 hours a day. Less than that and people become stressed, more than that and people become anxious.

Emily urged participants to help clients change the mindset with which they are approaching retirement. For example, instead of being stuck in a fixed mindset, we can encourage clients to focus on growth. Instead of measuring productivity, she offered up the Japanese model of Ikigai, which looks instead at the reasons we do the things we do.

Among the books Emily suggested as resources for retirement were William Bridges' books, Transitions: Making Sense of Life's Changes and Managing Transitions: Making the Most of Change; Daniel Pink's The Power of Regret. How Looking Backward Moves Us Forward and The Antidote: Happiness for People Who Can't Stand Positive Thinking by Oliver Burkeman.
