

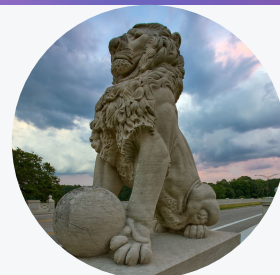


Christopher Newport University, located in Newport News, VA, is a dynamic university committed to student success.
